Science:

- Basic scientific concepts: Nature
Living organism, Plants
Animals and the
environment.
- Hands-on experiments and
Observation.
- Introduction to scientific enquiry
and the scientific method.

Social Studies:

- Introduction to community and
Society.
- Basics of History, Geography,
Culture and traditions.
- Developing an understanding of
different cultures and societies.

Art and Creativity :

- Drawing, Painting, Crafts and other forms of artistic expression
- Encouraging creativity and imaginations

Physical Education :

- Active play, sports and games
- Building motor skills, Co-ordinations and physical fitness

Computer Literacy :

- Basic computer skills, using educational software and internet safety

Character Education :

- Building social and emotional skills
- Promoting values such as respect, empathy and responsibility

Health and Hygiene:

- Personal hygiene, nutrition and healthy habits.

Environmental Studies:

- Developing awareness and understanding of environmental issues.
