Society.

• Basics of History, Geography,  
Culture and traditions.

• Developing an understanding of  
different cultures and societies.

## Art and Creativity :

- Drawing, Painting, Crafts and other forms of artistic expression
- Encouraging creativity and imaginations

## Physical Education :

- Active play, sports and games
- Building motor skills, co-ordinations and physical fitness.

## Computer Literacy :

- Basic computer skills, using educational software and internet safety.

## Character Education :

- Building social and emotional skills.
- Promoting values such as respect, empathy and responsibility.

## Health and Hygiene :

- Personal hygiene, nutrition and healthy habits.

## Environmental Studies :

- Developing awareness and understanding of environmental issues.
